Practise getting yourself dressed independently including zipping up your coat.

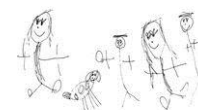


Take a picture of your house number and bring it in for our display.

 Where is your number? Eg door, wall.
 Can you recognise any other house numbers while you are out and about and where are they positioned?

Draw a picture of your family. Discuss what you have drawn with an adult. Get an adult to scribe / write down what you discuss.



Go on a nature walk. Discuss what you can see and hear. Collect natural materials that you find.



Complete finger gym activities to strengthen your muscles in your hands and develop your fine motor skills.

Talk about God's world with your family. Draw a picture of God's beautiful world / creations.



Continuous Learning – You must complete these activities weekly.

Reading	Share a story for 15 minutes every day.
Spelling	Nursery- Recognise your name, Reception- Recognise and spell your name (Remember a capital letter)
Maths	Recognise numbers: Nursery- up to 5, Reception- up to 10, Challenge- up to 20 and beyond.
